

Codices Vossiani Latini Online Invitation



Dear Sir, Madam,

The Latin manuscripts from the Isaac Vossius library are among the most valuable parts of Leiden University's Special Collections. Highlights include the earliest sources of *De rerum natura* by Lucretius and those of Cicero's philosophical works, the oldest extant illuminated herbal in Latin, and of course the 'Leiden Aratea' (with 39 magnificent constellation miniatures).

Brill and Leiden University Libraries have collaborated in digitizing the Codices Vossiani Latini and making these medieval sources available to a large community of scholars. In total the collection comprises 465 manuscripts in 363 (composite) volumes, counting over 80,000 pages. Users with a library card have free access via the Leiden catalogue. Other users can obtain acces via BrillOnline Primary Sources.

You are cordially invited to the presentation of *Codices Vossiani Latini Online* on **Thursday 29 October**. To mark the occasion two specialists will survey the breadth and depth of the collection. Furthermore, twenty of the finest manuscripts will be on display.
