IANLS Congress, Leuven 2021
Transnational Neo-Latin Drama

Members of the TransLatin project (www.translatin.nl) and associated members plan to organize one or more special sessions on Neo-Latin drama at the Congress of the IANLS to be held in Leuven in 2021. They invite proposals for papers addressing Neo-Latin plays or playwrights with transnational aspects. Topics addressed may include – but are not limited to – the following:

- connections with Neo-Latin dramas or playwrights from other countries
- relationship with vernacular dramas
- interpretation of Neo-Latin dramas in original and other contexts
- contemporary translations, adaptations and commentaries
- the use of digitized databases and creation of digital resources

Abstracts and proposed papers must conform to the norms presented in the First circular letter for the triennium 2018-2021. They are copied below, but also available for download at www.ianls.com.

Please send the abstracts (between 150 words minimum and 200 words maximum, adding a title of maximum 18 words, speaker's name, institutional affiliation (if any), address, email and phone) as WORD e-mail attachments to Jan Bloemendal (jan.bloemendal@huygens.knaw.nl) by 6 April 2020.

This will leave time for us to put together a proposal for one or more sessions and submit it by the official deadline.

SPECIAL SESSIONS (comprising no more than 3 papers. Roundtables are also admitted but only within the same time slot, 1.5 hours including the discussion)

- 1) title of session (max. 18 words)
 - 2) brief description of the concept of the session (50-100 words)
 - 3) name, institutional affiliation (if any), address, e-mail and phone of organizer(s) of session
 - 4) title of paper 1, abstract (min. 150-max. 200 words), speaker's name, and full details as above
 - 5) title of paper 2, abstract (min. 150-max. 200 words), speaker's name, and full details as above
 - 6) title of paper 3, abstract (min. 150-max. 200 words), speaker's name, and full details as above
- The proposal (including the individual abstracts) should be submitted by the session organizer(s) in a single WORD document. Please underline the names which should appear first in the alphabetical list of congress participants.
